

**Memorandum of Understanding
December 2021**

In the spirit of shared services and in exchange for taxes due, the Village of Falconer (Village) will provide the Falconer Central School District (District) the following list of services, materials and/or equipment use, as available, inclusive of, but not limited to:

- A Sewer Vacuum with two men to suck out water from the drywells two or three times a year.
- Equipment with four men to fill potholes in the Fenner and MS/HS lots, yearly.
- The loan of a bucket truck as needed.
- Loan of the dump truck as needed.
- Loan of miscellaneous hand tools including but not limited to: Jack Hammer and Concrete Saw.
- Removal of piled snow from the Fenner and MS/HS lots a minimum of twice a year. This requires a loader, truck and three men.
- A Roller and one man to roll the fields in the spring.(As needed)
- Regular route snow plowing of the section from the Motel circle to the Fenner parking lot.
- Salting around the Bus Garage as part of the regular route street sanding during the winter months.
- Street Sweeper around the Bus Garage a minimum of twice during the year.
- Mulch for playgrounds: when available and needed.
- Either party may cancel or terminate this Agreement at any time upon at least thirty (30) days advance written notice to the other party.

The District agrees to reimburse the Village for the aforementioned services at an amount not to exceed the Village's school tax obligation payable to the Falconer Central School District.

Village and District officials have met and agreed to the services, materials and/or equipment use to be rendered. The Board of Education, at their December 21, 2021 meeting, authorized the Superintendent of Schools to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding. The Village Board of Trustees, at their January 10, 2022 meeting, authorized the Mayor to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be reviewed annually by the Board of Education during its organizational session, at which time it shall review the Village billings from the previous year. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be reviewed annually by the Village Mayor and Board of Trustees at their organizational meeting, at which time they shall review the school tax bills. If no action is taken by either party to modify this agreement, it shall continue in force.
