## FALCONER PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD REPORT AUGUST 14, 2023 – SEPTEMBER 11, 2023

The final accounting of our 75<sup>th</sup> Annual Book Sale held on August 11, 12, and 13<sup>th</sup> has been done. We made \$4,069.86 on the sale. We added a donation jar this year and made \$365.00. Our on-going sale from August 2022 – July 2023 brought in \$1,135.00 for a grand total of \$5,569.86. Many thanks to our library board, staff, volunteers, DPW staff, village staff, and community members for their help and support!

During the month of August we also had an outdoor Yardzee and Farkle set raffle. The set was handcrafted and donated by Gil Lindahl and Martha Zenns. We appreciate their donation and support of our library.

We enjoyed our last summer band concert, Pearl City Jazz, on Wednesday, August 16<sup>th</sup>. This concert was rescheduled from July and was very well attended with 157 attending.

Laurie Becker and Sandy Thies set up a table at the Falconer Central School Back to School Bash on August 31<sup>st</sup>. We shared information about the library, our programs, volunteer opportunities and we brought one of our telescopes from the Martz Kohl Observatory Chautauqua Region Community Foundation Grant. The two Orion StarBlast 4.5 Astro Reflector Telescopes are barcoded and ready to be checked out!

Story Hour classes for three- and four-year-old children is scheduled to begin on September 13<sup>th</sup>. Story Hour Director, Ashley Nelson has 9 children pre-registered for these Wednesday morning classes.

Our application for a state construction grant with the Chautauqua-Cattaraugus Library System was approved. This grant will help with the cost of replacing the library's handicapped accessible door and renovations to this area. The work on this area is expected to begin soon.

The Library Board will meet on Thursday, September 28<sup>nd</sup> at 8:00 AM. We have invited members of the Chautauqua Region Community Foundation to join us.
