FALCONER PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD REPORT OCTOBER 11, 2023 – NOVEMBER 13, 2023

Story Hour Director Ashley Nelson presented “Fire Safety Day” classes for our 3 and 4-year-olds on October 11th. She invited the Falconer Fire Department to join us. Kayla Brentley read a fire safety book to the children. Ian Webster talked to them about the firefighting gear that is worn and showed them each piece as he put it on. Fire Chief Bryce Webster talked to the children about the importance of smoke detectors in the home and provided a new smoke detector for every child who attended to take home. We are so appreciative for their time, information and generosity. A new fire safety book has been purchased for the library and has been put in the Fire Department’s honor.

On November 2nd library patrons, Martha Zenns, Sue Johnson, Renee Abbott and Patty Kelderhouse took the time to hand stamp and create thank you cards for the library to use. Over 50 cards were created and donated!

The Chautauqua County Camera Club members are displaying their photos at the library for the month of November. An Open House to meet and talk to the photographers was held on November 4th from 10 AM – 12 PM.

We are waiting for contractor Nate Goot to schedule the reconstruction of the front entryway and the addition of a new handicapped accessible door.

EMS/RESCUE VEHICLE

I need the following motion:

***Resolved, that pursuant to Section 6-g of the General Municipal Law, as amended, there is hereby established a capital reserve fund to be known as the "Ambulance/EMS Reserve Fund." The purpose of this Reserve Fund is to accumulate monies to finance the cost of ambulance and/ or Rescue Vehicle acquisitions.

1. The Village is close to reimbursing the FFD-Vol Co for the paying off the lease for the Ambulance. We need to create a Reserve Fund to transfer the monies that the Village receives from Medex.
2. The Village needs to create a new sub-account in NYCLASS strictly for ambulance and/or Emergency Medical Service Reserve. The money that The Village receives from Medex billing will still be deposited in the General Fund @ M&T bank. Funds will be transferred to NYCLASS on monthly basis. The Village treasurer will initiate a wire transfer from M&T Bank to NYCLASS Ambulance/Rescue Vehicle.
