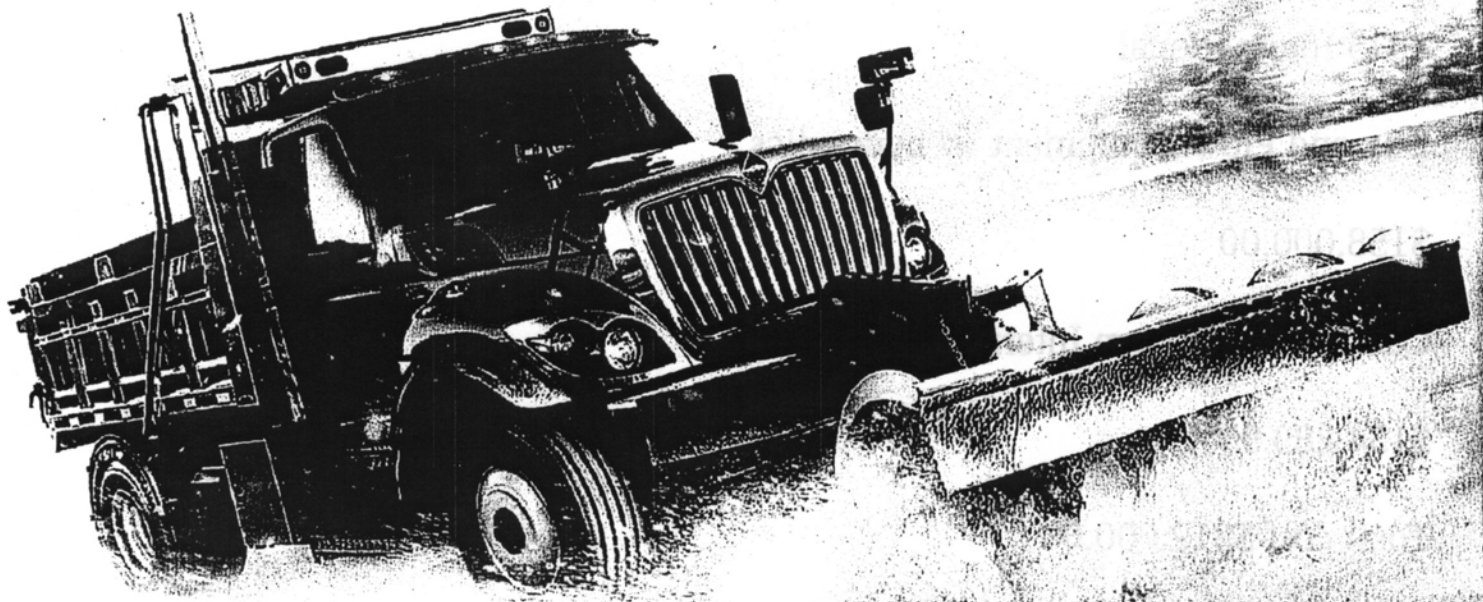

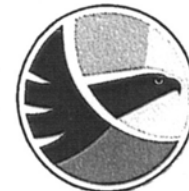

Mayor Jaroszynski and Trustees,

Thank you for taking the time to meet with me regarding our issues with our current building and location. I was proud to show you the technology and advancements we have made. With the businesses acquired over the last two years, after one hundred thirteen years and nine building additions in the Village of Falconer, we are finally running out of land. In review, I ask you and the village board to consider the following:

- 1) Designate No Parking on the east side of Merriam Street 165 feet south from East Main Street. Our loading dock has been on Merriam Street for 30 years with no issues. However, tenants living on the north side of East Main Street are parking on Merriam Street during the day. This causes issues with trucks backing into our dock. Until the last couple of years, no one had parked there, and it was not an issue. We can unload in the street, but it is not ideal. In the winter it is impossible.
- 2) There is a sewer line that runs through our parking lot from Work Street to Merriam Street. In order to expand our building, it needs to be moved. We met with the City of Jamestown BPU regarding moving the line. Their response was it is very feasible; however, it belongs to the Village of Falconer, and we need your permission to move it. We understand that it would be at our expense. We just request your permission.
- 3) We need to add between 3000-5000 sq. feet to our production space to continue to grow. Two plots that we own are at issue. Plots 063803-371.07-2-42 and 063803-371.07-2-37 are in our parking lot and 063803-371.07-2-33 is currently a residence that will be razed. I ask you to consider a resolution to rezone all three plots as commercial. See attached for the plots in question.
- 4) Remove and replace the trees on the terrace in front of our building. They are overgrown and are hazardous for drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

WHEREAS, Section 104-b of the General Municipal Law required the governing body of every municipality to adopt internal policies and procedures governing all procurement of goods and services which are not required by law to be publicly bid, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of the Village of Falconer in a regular session duly convened that the Village of Falconer does hereby adopt the following procurement policy which is intended to apply to all goods and services which are not required by law to be publicly bid.

**PROCUREMENT POLICY FOR THE VILLAGE OF FALCONER**

1. A. Every prospective purchase of goods to be made must be initially reviewed to determine whether it is a purchase contract or a public works contract. Once that determination is made, a good faith effort will be made to determine whether it is known or can reasonably be expected that the aggregate amount to be spent on the item of supply or service is not subject to competitive bidding, taking into account past purchases and the aggregate amount to be spent in a year.

B. The following items are not subject to competitive bidding pursuant to Section 103 of the General Municipal Law: purchase contracts under \$20,000 and public works contracts under \$35,000; emergency purchases; certain municipal hospital purchases; goods purchased from agencies for the blind or severely handicapped; goods purchased from correctional institutions; purchases under state and county contracts and surplus and secondhand purchases from another government entity.

C. The decision that a purchase is not subject to competitive bidding will be documents in writing by the individual making the purchase. The document may include written or verbal quotes from vendors, a memo from the purchaser indicating how the decision was arrived at, a copy of the contract indicating the source which makes the item or service exempt, a memo from the purchaser detailing the circumstances which led to an emergency purchase or any other written documentation that is appropriate.

2. All goods and services not subject to competitive bidding will be secured by use of written requests for proposals (RFP), written quotations, verbal quotations or any other method that assures that good will be purchased at the lowest price and that favoritism will be avoided. A written purchase requisition must accompany the above document(s) and be approved by the mayor prior to purchasing any goods and services. The mayor may give verbal approval for time-sensitive purchases.

3. Only one (1) village credit card may be issued and held in the Clerk/Treasurer's office. All authorized credit card purchases, without exception, must be made through central purchasing in the Clerk/Treasurer office. No other village employee, including department managers, fire chiefs, fire captains etc.) may obtain and/or use a separate credit card for any purchase made with village/tax payer funds. If a purchase is made outside of this policy, the village retains the right to refuse payment. The purchase liability and responsibility for payment will become that of the purchaser. *(added per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*

4. A. The following method of purchase will be used when required by this policy in order to achieve the highest savings:

B. Any written purchase requisition and RFP shall describe the desired goods, quantity and the particulars of delivery. The purchase shall compile a list of all vendors from whom written/fax/oral quotes have been requested and the written/fax/oral quotes offered. Related purchases may not be split up to circumvent this policy under \$125 requirement. *(Amended per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*

C. A good faith effort shall be made to obtain the required number of proposals or quotations. If the purchaser is unable to obtain the required number of proposals or quotations, the purchaser will document the attempt made at obtaining the proposals. In no event shall the failure to obtain the proposals be a bar to procurement.

D. Section 3 Business Participation in Procurement and Contracting: For federally funded projects or activities subject to Section 3 of 24 CFR Part 135 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended, the Village will, to the greatest extent feasible, facilitate participation of Section 3 residents and Section 3 businesses in the procurement of goods and services pursuant to its Section 3 Participation Plan. Solicitation may be undertaken via advertisements in local publications encouraging Section 3 participation, or direct outreach by letter or email to identified Section 3 businesses or individuals included on the Department of Housing and Urban Development's Section 3 Businesses Registry. The Village's established purchase/ contracting thresholds will apply. The Village will keep documentation of Section 3 solicitation in its records and any response(s) thereto. *(Amended per Resolution dated 5/9/2022)*

E. Minority- and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (M/WBE) Business Participation in Procurement and Contracting: In an effort to affirmatively increase procurement and contracting opportunities for minority- and women-owned business enterprises, the Village will solicit MBEs and/or WBEs as part of its procurement process, when appropriate. Solicitation may be undertaken via advertisements in minority publications or direct outreach by letter or email to identified State-certified

M/WBEs, or by working with a clearinghouse such as the Syracuse Minority Business Development Center. The Village's established purchase/contracting thresholds will apply. For purposes of the above, the M/WBE must be certified by Empire State Development (ESD) through the Division of Minority and Women Business Development (DMWBD). The Village will keep documentation of M/WBE solicitation in its records and any responses thereto. *(Amended per Resolution dated 5/9/2022)*

F. All information gathered in complying with the procedures of this policy shall be preserved and filed with the documentation supporting the subsequent purchase or public works contract.

5. The lowest responsible proposal or quote shall be awarded the purchase or public works contract unless the purchaser prepares a written justification providing reasons why it is in the best interest of the Village and its taxpayers to make an award to other than the low proposer. If a proposer is not deemed responsible, facts supporting that judgment shall also be documented and filed with the records supporting the procurement.

6. Pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 104-b(2)(f) the solicitation of alternative proposals or quotations will not be required in the best interest of the municipality in the following circumstances where proper qualifications are not necessarily found in the individual or company that offers the lowest price and the nature of these services are such that they do not readily lend themselves to competitive procurement procedures;

A. Professional services or services requiring special or technical skill, training or expertise. The individual or company must be chosen based on accountability, reliability, responsibility, skill, education and training, judgment, integrity and moral worth.

In determining whether a service shall fit into this category, the Trustees shall take into consideration the following guidelines:

- (a) Whether the services are subject to state licensing or testing requirements;
- (b) Whether substantial formal education or training is a necessary prerequisite to the performance of the services; and
- (c) Whether the services require a personal relationship between the individual and municipal officials.

Professional and technical services shall include but not be limited to the following: services of an attorney; services of a physician; technical services of an engineer or architect engaged to prepare plans, maps and estimates; securing insurance coverage and/or services of an insurance broker; services of a certified public accountant; investment management services; printing services involving extensive writing, editing or artwork; management of municipally owned property; and computer software or programming services for customized programs or services involved in substantial modification and customizing or pre-packaged software.

B. Emergency purchases pursuant to Section 103(4) of the General Municipal Law. Due to the nature of this exception, these goods or services must be purchased immediately and delay in order to seek alternate proposals may threaten life, health, safety or welfare of the residents. This section does not preclude alternate proposals if time permits.

C. Purchases of surplus and secondhand goods from any source. If alternate proposals are required, the Village is precluded from purchasing surplus and secondhand goods at auctions or through

specific advertised sources where the best prices are usually contained. It is also difficult to try to compare prices of used goods and a lower price may indicate an older product.

7. Section 3 Business Participation in Procurement and Contracting: For federally funded projects or activities subject to Section 3 of 24 CFR Part 135 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended, the Village will, to the greatest extent feasible, facilitate participation of Section 3 residents and Section 3 businesses in the procurement of goods and services pursuant to its Section 3 Participation Plan. Solicitation may be undertaken via advertisements in local publications encouraging Section 3 participation, or direct outreach by letter or email to identified Section 3 businesses or individuals included on the Department of Housing and Urban Development's Section 3 Businesses Registry. The Village's established purchase/ contracting thresholds will apply. The Village will keep documentation of Section 3 solicitation in its records and any response(s) thereto.  
*(Amended per Resolution dated 5/9/2022)*
8. Minority- and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (M/WBE) Business Participation in Procurement and Contracting: In an effort to affirmatively increase procurement and contracting opportunities for minority- and women-owned business enterprises, the Village will solicit MBEs and/or WBEs as part of its procurement process, when appropriate. Solicitation may be undertaken via advertisements in minority publications or direct outreach by letter or email to identified State-certified M/WBEs, or by working with a clearinghouse such as the Syracuse Minority Business Development Center. The Village's established purchase/contracting thresholds will apply. For purposes of the above, the M/WBE must be certified by Empire State Development (ESD) through the Division of Minority and Women Business Development (DMWBD). The Village will keep documentation of M/WBE solicitation in its records and any responses thereto. *(Amended per Resolution dated 5/9/2022)*
9. All Travel expenses, including but not limited to food, lodging, tolls, etc. will be paid for upfront by the employee. Upon completion of the trip, all pre-approved travel expenses should be submitted for reimbursement using the village's Reimbursement Form, along with supporting documents and detailed receipts, etc. Reimbursement payments will be made to the employee following approval of the payment by the village's board of trustees. *(added per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*
  - A. Work related travel expenses over \$125 per person require a purchase requisition and approval PRIOR to arranging the trip. Reimbursement for all approved travel expenses will be reimbursed based on detailed receipts. Failure to obtain preapproval and/or supply detailed receipts may result in refusal by village to reimburse all or part of the associated travel expenses. *(added per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*
  - B. Expenses for spouses, partners, and guests are not reimbursable, unless the spouse, partner or guest is on a preapproved work-related trip. *(added per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*
  - C. Work related travel meals will be reimbursed up to \$60/day for each employee and may NOT include tips or alcohol. Detailed receipts are required for reimbursement. *(added per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*
10. Items purchased on behalf of the village and/or its subsidiaries and/or departments, may never be discarded or dispersed in any fashion, without pre-approval from the mayor and/or Board of Trustees. All items must be discarded in accordance with the village's Records Management Policy (MU-1). *(added per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*

11. The village Treasurer must maintain an updated record of inventory for all village property within each department. Electronic devices often hold highly sensitive information and, therefore require strict monitoring of such inventory, including, but not limited to computers, phones, printers, faxes, scanners and related, hardware, software and/or electronic storage devices of all kinds. *(added per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*
  
12. All employees, including managers and staff, should be trained on the village Procurement Policies and purchase requisition requirements.
  1. Each manager and employee must also be provided a written and updated copy of the village Procurement Policy.
  2. Each manager and employee must sign an acknowledgment that they have read, been trained and understand village Procurement Policy and purchase requisition requirements. *(added per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*
  
13. No portion of this resolution shall be construed as preventing the competitive bidding of purchase contracts under \$20,000 or public works projects under \$35,000, if so desired.
  
14. This policy shall be reviewed annually by the Trustees at its organizational meeting or as so thereafter is reasonably practicable.
  
15. If any employee fails to follow the village Procurement Policy as written in this resolution, the following disciplinary actions will be taken:
  1. First occurrence: Employee will receive verbal reprimand along with counselling and a written memo of occurrence, which must be signed by the Mayor, the employee and filed with the village clerk. (see Employee Discipline Notice)
  2. Second occurrence: Written reprimand to be placed in employee file for a period of 1 year. The letter of reprimand must be acknowledged by Mayor, the employee and recorded with the village clerk. (see Employee Discipline Notice)
  3. Third occurrence: Immediate suspension of purchasing privileges. (see Employee Discipline Notice)
  4. Forth occurrence: Possible dismissal from employment and/or volunteer duties/positions of authority. (see Employee Discipline Notice) *(added per Resolution dated 7/8/2019)*
  
16. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

**TOWN OF ELLICOTT LOCAL LAW #1 of 2023**  
**BEST VALUE COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND PROCUREMENT**

**Section 1. Title**

This Local Law shall be known as the "Town of Ellicott Local Law #1 of 2023, a local law Authorizing Best Value Competitive Bidding and Procurement."

**Section 2. Legislative Intent and Purpose**

The Town Board seeks to exercise the local option set forth in § 103 of the General Municipal Law, which authorizes the Town to award purchase contracts and service contracts subject to competitive bidding under § 103 of the General Municipal Law on the basis of either the lowest responsible bidder or "best value", as defined in § 163 of the New York State Finance Law. This authorization provides the greatest measure of flexibility in the Town's public bidding procedures and ensures the best value and price for the residents of the Town of Ellicott.

**Section 3. Authority**

This local law is enacted pursuant to the New York Municipal Home Rule Law, as authorized pursuant to New York State General Municipal Law § 103 and the New York State Finance Law § 163 and any other provisions of law authorizing the Town of Ellicott to enter into contracts and engage in contracting for services.

**Section 4. Best Value Competitive Bidding**

A. Authority and Purpose.

Section 103 of the New York General Municipal Law allows the Town to authorize, by local law, the award of certain purchase contracts (including contracts for services) subject to competitive bidding under General Municipal Law § 103 on the basis of "best value" as defined in Section 163 of the New York State Finance Law. The "best value" option may be used if it is more cost-efficient over time to award the contract for goods or services to other than the lowest responsible bidder if factors such as lower cost of maintenance, durability, higher quality, and longer product life can be documented.

B. Award Based on Best Value.

The Town Board may award purchase contracts and service contracts that have been procured pursuant to competitive bidding under General Municipal Law § 103 by either the lowest responsible bidder or on the basis of "best value" as the term is defined in New York State Finance law § 163. All contracts or purchase orders awarded based on best-value bidding bases shall require Town Board approval.

C. Applicability.

The provisions of this local law apply to Town purchase contracts, including contracts for services, involving an expenditure of more than \$20,000, but excluding purchase contracts necessary for the completion of a public works contract pursuant to Article 8 of the New York Labor Law and any other contract that may in the future be excluded under state law from the best value option. If the dollar thresholds of New York General Municipal Law §103 are increased or decreased in the future by the State Legislature, the dollar thresholds set forth herein shall be superseded by such § 103, and this local law shall be read as if the numbers are amended to conform to said § 103.

D. Standard for Best Value.

1. Goods and services procured and awarded on the basis of best value are those that the Town Board determines to optimize quality, cost, and efficiency among responsive and responsible bidders, as set forth in the procurement policy of the Town, as time-to-time and hereafter amended by the Town Board.

2. Where possible the determination shall be based on an objective and quantifiable analysis of clearly described and documented criteria as they apply to the rating of bids or offers.

3. The criteria may include, but shall not be limited to, any or all of the following: cost of maintenance; proximity to the contractors; longer product life; product performance criteria; quality of craftsmanship.

#### E. Documentation.

Whenever any contract is awarded on the basis of best value instead of lowest responsible bidder, the basis for determining best value shall be thoroughly and accurately documented.

#### F. Piggybacking of purchases.

Notwithstanding the provisions of this Local Law, the Town of Ellicott may, for purposes of public purchases, utilize the provisions of General Municipal Law § 103 with regard to the so-called "piggybacking" of purchases. The Town of Ellicott may piggyback whenever allowed by law, including but not limited to the following situations and criteria:

1. Pursuant to General Municipal Law § 103 the Town of Ellicott may purchase through the bids solicited and bid lists generated by the United States government and New York State (and its political subdivisions and school districts) whenever such bids or bid lists are generated in a manner as complies with said § 103.

2. If not a bid or list generated by a New York State governmental body or agency, then whenever such contract or bid lists were let in a manner consistent with or materially equivalent to the requirements of the State of New York as reflected in the policy and language of said § 103.

3. The Town may also piggyback upon any contract or foreign bid or bid list specifically approved for piggybacking through the New York State Office of General Services, as well as foreign bids and bid lists (mainly, of sister states) that meet the above criteria for piggybacking as set forth in sections 4(F)(1) or 4(F)(2) of this local law, immediately above.

#### G. Procurement Policy Superseded Where Inconsistent.

Any inconsistent provision of the Town's procurement policy, as adopted prior to the effective date of this Local Law by resolution of the Town Board, or as amended thereafter, shall be deemed superseded by the provisions of this local law.

### **Section 5. Severability**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

### **Section 6. Effective Date**

This local law shall take effect immediately

# FIRST ADDENDUM TO WASTEWATER SERVICES AGREEMENT

This First Addendum to Wastewater Services Agreement is made this \_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2024, by and between:

**CITY OF JAMESTOWN BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES**, with offices at 92 Steele Street, Jamestown, New York 14701, hereinafter referred to as “the BPU”; and the

**VILLAGE OF FALCONER, NEW YORK**, a municipal corporation having its principal office at 101 West Main Street, Falconer, New York 14733 hereinafter referred to as “the VILLAGE.”

## RECITALS

**WHEREAS**, the BPU and the Village, hereinafter “Parties” entered into an agreement dated June 29, 2023, hereinafter the “Agreement”, under which the BPU agreed to provide municipal sanitary sewer services to the Village upon certain terms and conditions as described in that Agreement, and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desire to modify that Agreement in order to provide a funding mechanism for the Village’s payment of those operation and maintenance expenses which are excluded expenses under Section 6 of that Agreement,

**NOW, THEREFORE**, upon the foregoing and mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. A new paragraph is added to the end of Section 6, “Operation and Maintenance,” as follows:

*The Village may, upon written notice provided by the Mayor of the Village, direct the BPU to bill Village customers an additional amount not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the Jamestown rate, to be held in an account for the express purpose of paying Village operation and maintenance expenses under this Section of the Agreement which do not qualify for Capital Improvement Fund payments.*

2. Each section of the Agreement which is not modified by this First Addendum shall continue in full force and effect.
